BE SURE TO RECEIVE THE CREDIT YOU EARNED!

Continuing Legal Education (CLE) accreditation has been requested from each jurisdiction with mandatory CLE requirements.

A maximum of 10 general credit hours, including 2.5 ethics credit hours, has been requested from those states granting credit hours on a 60-minute credit basis, and 12 general credit hours, including 3.0 ethics credit hours, has been requested from jurisdictions that recognize the 50-minute credit basis.

To obtain CLE credit, you must attend the educational session and swipe your badge at the sensor equipment provided in each education session room within the first 15 minutes of the session. Only those persons who attend the session and swipe their badges will receive credit for that session. You must save your receipts each time you swipe.

INTA maintains a CLE information desk on Level 100 of the Metro Toronto Convention Centre. If your jurisdiction requires a specific form, you must pick it up at this desk and fill it out onsite to receive full credit. *CLE credit cannot be issued after the Annual Meeting.*
